

### ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

Kasthurba College for Women the erstwhile Villianur College for Women was established in the year 2005 under the aegis of Pondicherry Society for Higher Education wholly run by the Government of Pondicherry to cater to the higher educational needs of the women students hailing from rural background. Internal Complaints Committee

The Choice Based Credit System was introduced in the College from the academic year 2017-18 to design a curriculum to suit individual needs & mobility across related disciplines. Students need to study courses like Discipline Specific Core Courses, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses, Public Administration, Environment Awareness etc.

Credit is a unit by which the course is measured and it determines the number of hours of instruction needed for a week. One credit is equivalent to one hour of teaching (lecture of tutorial) or two hours of practical work/field work per week.

Letter grades shall be used to assess the performance of students in each course by converting final marks (out of 100) into grades. in case of fractions the marks shall be rounded off to next integer. The following shall be used to convert marks into awarding grades:

**Letter Grade**: It is an index of the performance of students in a said course. Grades are denoted by letters O, A+, A,B+, B,C,P and F.

### **COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- Students are expected to use only courteous and polite language and behave with decorum while talking to the faculty and other members and the staff of the college.
- 2. Students should avoid using any insulting, threatening language while talking with fellow students and should totally avoid violence. Students should not talk in any manner inside/outside the institution in a way that would bring disrepute to the institution.
- Students should be regular and punctual in attending classes and all activities connected with the college.
- On entering the class, they should observe strict silence, irrespective of the presence or absence of the teacher.
- They should get up quietly as the teacher enters the class and keep standing till the latter sits or asks them to be seated. Every student must obey the teacher and carry out the instructions.
- No student is permitted to leave the classroom during class hours.
- Students are expected to read notices/circulars displayed on the College Notice Board. Ignorance or not reading any notice/circular thus displayed shall not be accepted as an excuse failing to comply with the directions contained therein.
- 8. While attending college functions, the students should conduct themselves in such a way as to bring credit to themselves and the institution.
- Smoking and abuse-of drugs within the-campus are strictly prohibited.

- 10. Students are forbidden from entering the college office and the staff rooms during unspecified hours.
- Pasting of wall posters, writing on walls and roads are prohibited.
- 12. The Principal's decision shall be final in all matters of punishment of the students for violation of any of the rules and regulations of the college.
- Breaking/damaging the college property is strictly prohibited. The cost of damages/broken items will be recovered from those who indulge in such activities.
- Students who have been convicted of any offence in a criminal court will not be allowed to continue their studies in the college.
- Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited. Anyone who
  is found guilty of ragging will summarily and severely
  be punished.
- 16. All students must attend the college in a dress code.
- Students need to be regular and punctual to classes and activities related with the college.
- Students need to inform the concerned head of the department if they want to leave the campus during working hours.
- Mobile phone is strictly prohibited inside the classroom.
- Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited. Anyone found guilty of ragging will be punished.

### Attendance and Leave of Absence

The students are expected to be in their place during the stated periods for lectures, seminars, theoretical classes and practical classes. Attendance will be taken during each period and absence for that period will be considered as absence for that whole session. A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to apply for the semester exam conducted by the University.

- Students are not allowed to bring personal belongings such as books, notebooks or bags to the library. They can take notes on sheets of papers.
- Writing, marking, underlining, or any damage to the reading books will result in disciplinary action.

If the individual loses the book or in case of inability to return the book, she should pay the fine. The amount of fine is double the cost for books or material that are available in the market and four times the cost of book or material that are out of print.
